

# TOMATOES

FRESH MARKET **Tomasín**



**Tomasín** has a very vigorous semi-determinate plant. It produces large fruit with a tight blossom end. They are oblate in shape with an attractive red color both inside and out and no green shoulders

**Tomasín** is very firm and uniform, and thanks to its excellent disease package, it delivers high yields under stressful conditions.

RESISTANCE is defined as the ability of a plant variety to highly restrict the activities of a specific pathogen or insect pest and/or restrict the symptoms and signs of a disease when compared to susceptibility varieties. TOLERANCE is defined as the ability of the plant to endure or recover from damage caused by an adverse environmental or chemical stress.

GUIDE TO DISEASES: BSK - Bacterial Speck (*Pseudomonas syringae* pv. tomato); ASC - Alternaria stem canker (*Alternaria alternata* f sp. lycopersici, races 1,2,&3); F - Fusarium wilt (*Fusarium oxysporum* f sp. lycopersici, races 1,2,& 3), FCRR - Fusarium Crown Root Rot; St - Grey leaf spot (*Stemphylium solani*); V - Verticillium wilt (*Verticillium dahliae*, race 1); N- Southern root-knot nematode (*Meloidogyne incognita*, *M. arenaria*, *M. javanica*, race 1); ToMV - Tomato mosaic virus (Strains: 0, 1 & 2); TYLCV - Tomato yellow leaf curl virus.
